1

Fill out an adoption application

Wait for an email from an adoption counselor

- After your application has been reviewed, an adoption counselor will contact you via email to discuss your application.
- These emails typically take about 2 days to arrive. If you have not received an email from us in that time, please make sure to check your spam or junk mail folder.

3**

Meet the adoptable animals

- If your application is approved, the adoption counselor will work with you to set up a suitable time to visit the rescue and meet the adoptable animals.
- Please come to your adoption appointment prepared to pay an adoption fee.
- Please bring a carrier suitable for transporting your new pet(s) home with you.

4**

Enjoy your new pet(s)!
